In 2005 we established the Women's Transportation Seminar, WTS London, the first European Chapter of the body founded in the United States in 1977.

In establishing a chapter in London and becoming part of WTS International, we aim to promote and support the professional development of women working in the field of transport.

Women are typically under-represented in the transport industry and while there are many women's equality networks and groups our organisation is focused specifically on employment and career advancement within the industry.

Through the London chapter we provide a platform for dialogue between those women working in transport in the UK as well as a range of opportunities and benefits such as career development, training and mentoring schemes.

## Benefits

As well as providing authoritative transport information and research, WTS London provides a variety of opportunities to promote and support women working in transport.

WTS London is working in partnership with organisations with similar aims and is encouraging them to share best practice. We offer a lively events programme with speakers who are leaders and experts in their fields. There are also seminars, training and development opportunities, mentoring and research programmes.

For corporate members, benefits include places for employees at WTS events, recognition as a supporter of a ground-breaking organisation and excellent networking opportunities.

The WTS mission is the success of women in transport. Membership of WTS London is open to all, irrespective of gender and includes representation from the private, public and the not-for-profit sector.



## Type of membership

### Full Membership

Members shall be eligible for all benefits of the organisation including nomination to office, committee and working parties, voting privileges, all mailing and organisation materials, affiliation with WTS International.

### Student Membership

Students enrolled full-time in courses or programmes in the transport field at higher education colleges or universities within the geographic area shall be eligible for all benefits of membership except nomination to office, committee or working party and voting privileges.

### Affiliate Membership

Available to persons located outside the area of the geographic boundary of the Women’s Transportation Seminar, London.

### Retired Membership

Members who have permanently retired shall be eligible for all benefits of membership except nomination to office, committee or working party and voting privileges.

### Corporate Membership

Available to agencies, consultancies, trade associations and other companies wishing to show support for the organisation. Fees and the number of representatives eligible for all

benefits of full membership are determined by the level of sponsorship.

Membership will normally be for twelve months, and will be renewed on the anniversary of your joining date.
